Apostolic Age APOSTOLIC AGE. The period in the history of the Christian church when the apostles were alive, beginning with the Day of Pentecost and ending with the death of the apostle John near the end of the first century. The closing years of the apostolic age (A.D.) remain one of the obscurest periods of church history due to the scantiness of information relating to this period. It seems that all of the New Testament books, except for John's writings (A.D.), had been written by the time Jerusalem was destroyed (70 A.D.).
